WHAT LOVE LOOKS LIKE

Matthew 16:24 Then Jesus said to His disciples, If anyone desires to be My disciple, let him deny himself [disregard, lose sight of, and forget himself and his own interests] and take up his cross and follow Me [cleave steadfastly to Me, conform wholly to My example in living and, if need be, in dying, also]. 25 For whoever is bent on saving his [temporal] life [his comfort and security here] shall lose it [eternal life];

25 For whoever is bent on saving his [temporal] life [his comfort and security here] shall lose it [eternal life]; and whoever loses his life [his comfort and security here] for My sake shall find it [life everlasting]. 26 For what will it profit a man if he gains the whole world and forfeits his life [his blessed life in the kingdom of God]? Or what would a man give as an exchange for his [blessed] life [in the kingdom of God]? AMPC

What Jesus is saying is if we want to be His disciple, we have a part in fulfilling the Father's dream. As His disciples, we have to give up our lives as did Jesus, to fulfill that dream the Father has.

HIS DREAM IS THAT NONE SHOULD PERISH, BUT ALL WOULD HAVE ETERNAL LIFE!

THE FULFILMENT OF THE MOST IMPORTANT COMMAND

Matthew 22:37 And He replied to him, You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind (intellect) 38 This is the great (most important, principal) and first commandment. 39 And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as [you do] yourself.

To love God —is to care about what God cares about and He cares about your neighbor, which is the second most important command. Therefore to love God is what is important to Him, to love your neighbor more than yourself will please the Father.

To lay down your life, your desires, for those who are lost is to care about what God cares about.

It is God's will that none should perish. It is His dream, His heartache that none would miss out on living with Him for eternity.

WHY JESUS HAS NOT RETURNED YET

2 Peter 3:9 The Lord does not delay and is not tardy or slow about what He promises, according to some people's conception of slowness, but He is long-suffering (extraordinarily patient) toward you, not desiring that any should perish, but that all should turn to repentance.

Many call themselves Christians but have no idea of their role in what it means to be committed to Jesus. They as well have no idea the pain Jesus is in as He waits for us to respond to His heart's cry.

Jesus is suffering while He waits for us to do our part. We are not waiting for Him, but He is waiting for us.

ONE WHO TRULY LOVES GOD

If you love Jesus, you will not be ignorant of His pain. You will care so much about what He cares about, that you will want to give your life away. You will want to give up your personal desires for Him. You will earnestly want to be a part of His life.

You won't be trying to get out of being a part of His life, but you will be working to be a part of His life. You will want to know Him and everything about Him.

Jesus said He laid down His life willingly. It was His desire to do what His Father wanted Him to do.

John 10:18 No one takes it away from Me. On the contrary, I lay it down voluntarily. [I put it from Myself.] I am authorized and have power to lay it down (to resign it) and I am authorized and have power to take it back again. These are the instructions (orders) which I have received [as My charge] from My Father.

Giving up your life is a choice as well. To love others before yourself is a choice. That is what Jesus did. He loved, He humbled Himself and loved us before anything. His passion was to love us beyond our wildest dreams.

THE RICH MAN

Mark 10:17 And as He was setting out on His journey, a man ran up and knelt before Him and asked Him, Teacher, [You are essentially and perfectly morally] good, what must I do to inherit eternal life [that is, to partake of eternal salvation in the Messiah's kingdom]? 18 And Jesus said to him, Why do you call Me [essentially and perfectly morally] good? There is no one [essentially and perfectly morally] good—except God alone. 19 You know the commandments: Do not kill, do not commit adultery, do not steal, do not bear false witness, do not defraud, honor your father and mother. 20 And he replied to Him, Teacher, I have carefully guarded and observed all these and taken care not to violate them from my boyhood. 21 And Jesus, looking upon him, loved him, and He said to him, You lack one thing; go and sell all you have and give [the money] to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come [and] accompany Me [walking the same road that I walk]. 22 At that saying the man's countenance fell and was gloomy, and he went away grieved and sorrowing, for he was holding great possessions. AMPC

The rich man was unwilling to give up His life to love others, but he was willing to give up eternal life for his stuff.

Remember his question —Lord, what do I have to do to have eternal life? Jesus answered by saying sell. your things give to the poor and follow Me.

He was saying the same thing to the rich young ruler as He said to the disciples.

If you want to be my disciple, you must give up your own interests, your life and follow Me. Like Jesus gave up His life, we have to give up ours If we want to be His.

If you want to be His disciple. If you want to be a part of His life — you will inherit eternal life. But if you would rather have temporary satisfactions here, know that you will not inherit eternal life when you leave here. If you don't love Jesus more than your anything, you will not inherit eternal life.

The legacy of Jesus is to love. To love beyond what we thought love was. To humble ourselves to the place of exalting the other person above ourselves, giving up our life, our comfort for the sake of theirs.

The ultimate goal, aiding in the Fathers dream to come true, that not one should perish.



YOU DON'T *have to be* SICK

As much joy as it would bring to you to take away your child's pain, it brings Him that much joy.

Like aging and like dying, having to be sick seems to be an inevitable part of life, but it's not. Not if you know the truth. The truth, you might ask? Yes, the truth that Jesus bore your sickness, disease, sorrow and your pain.

Isaiah 53:4 Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and

carried our sorrows and pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy].
5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our guilt and iniquities; the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace and well-being for us was upon Him, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed and made whole. AMPC

Since Jesus became sick for us, bore our sorrow, pain, weaknesses, sickness and disease, we don't have to be sick. In fact, should we even tolerate sickness knowing all that He went through to purchase our well-being? Wouldn't it be like saying yes, I know what you did for me, but I don't want your gift?

Imagine the rejection He feels when we reject His willingness to give Himself for us and we won't take it.

One day while writing, I heard the Lord say this to me. "It hurt Me that you hurt, that's why I hurt for you".

I knew He was saying that He couldn't stand the agony of watching us suffer, to see us sorrowful, bound in sickness and disease, so He did something about it.

As much joy as it would bring to you to take away your child's pain, it brings Him that much joy.

My son was born with a birth defect, and the diagnosis wasn't good. He had two surgeries in his first week of life, which was very difficult for my husband and me to assimilate.

One evening when I came home from the hospital, I found my husband lying on the floor in our son's room, begging God to take him so that our baby could be okay. The same thing my husband wanted to do and I am sure many other parents would want to do, Jesus did for us. He died, He bled, and gave His life for our well-being so we could be comforted in health and wellness! He did what we couldn't do.

He did for us what my husband wanted to do, but couldn't. He satisfied our desire to make our babies better by suffering for us.

It's amazing to me how we are so much like God, that we have the same desires as He does. The same pain we have for those we love, He has for His children.

There was a time when I didn't understand this kind of love. I distinctly remember the day. I was about seven, I was alone and standing in the balcony of my church, hungry to hear the Word of God. The Pastor told the Easter story and as I listened, I fell apart! I was distraught; I couldn't stop crying.

I couldn't understand how God would let such an awful thing happen to His Son. Sobbing, I asked Him, how could You let this happen? Why would You let Your Son suffer like this, why did You let them kill Him? I must not have heard the whole story and how Jesus was raised from the dead. I don't remember hearing that part, but I do remember how disappointed I was in the God I thought I knew. I don't remember what happened after that, but it scared me and I was hungry for the reason He would allow this trauma.

Just like the Word mentions In Isaiah 53:3, we ignorantly considered Jesus stricken, smitten and afflicted by God, that was me. I assumed the same.

Isaiah 53:4 —Surely He has borne our griefs (sicknesses, weaknesses, and distresses) and carried our sorrows and pains [of punishment], yet we [ignorantly] considered Him stricken, smitten, and afflicted by God [as if with leprosy].
5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our guilt and iniquities; the chastisement [needful to obtain] peace and well-being for us was upon Him, and with the stripes [that wounded] Him we are healed and made whole. AMPC

This Truth is the truth I grew to know, that it was God's plan to give His Son to gain many more sons and daughters. I know now, it was a plan for our well-being.

Isaiah 53:10 Even though it pleased Yahweh to crush him with grief, he will be restored to favor. After his soul becomes a guilt-offering, he will gaze upon his many offspring and prolong his days. And through him, Yahweh's deepest desires will be fully accomplished. 11After the great anguish of his soul, he will see light and be fully satisfied. By knowing him, the righteous one, my servant will make many to be righteous, because he, their sin-bearer, carried away their sins. TPT

He had a plan, a plan I didn't know about. He had intentions above and beyond what I could think of myself. His intention for our well-being here, and for everlasting life with Him when we leave here, was way out of my reach that day.

Now I understand, and I am grateful for the provision He has made for me and for you.

John 10:10 I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows).

John 10:17 For this [reason] the Father loves Me, because I lay down My [own] life—to take it back again. 18 No one takes it away from Me. On the contrary, I lay it down voluntarily. [I put it from Myself.] I am authorized and have power to lay it down (to resign it) and I am authorized and have power to take it back again. These are the instructions (orders) which I have received [as My charge] from My Father. AMPC

Jesus willingly took upon our sin, and by His wounds we were made whole. If you can believe that, you never have to be sick again.

James 1:12 Blessed (happy, to be envied) is the man who is patient under trial and stands up under temptation, for when he has stood the test and been approved, he will receive [the victor's] crown of life which God has promised to those who love Him. AMPC

Does it seem like all you are going through is so so very unfair? Like you were serving the Lord the best you knew how, and now all these things are coming up that you didn't expect and it has just blown you away? You're thinking, how did I get here? What happened? Well, what happened was you were following after the Spirit and He led you into the wilderness to be tempted and tested by the enemy.

Jesus wasn't tested for just 40 days when He fasted; He was tested beyond that. The enemy tested Him to quit and give up in His ministry daily, since the very beginning. The church people at one point, tried to push him over the cliff.

The most outrageous test was when He gave His life. Even though He knew this was the plan, even though God showed you the plan, when it came right down to it, how unfair was it? How awful did it feel? To love God with all your heart, soul and mind and be so mistreated for doing good? Even though you gave it your all, now this happens. Whatever *this* is, this is your test.

Jesus was tempted to quit in the garden. He said Father, is there any other way, any other way to accomplish salvation? This is much too hard. What about all my friends, my Mother, those I dearly and tenderly love? I don't want to leave them. But nevertheless, Your will be done.

Mark 14:35 And going a little farther, He fell on the ground and kept praying that if it were possible the [fatal] hour might pass from Him. 36 And He was saying, Abba, [which means] Father, everything is possible for You. Take away this cup from Me; yet not what I will, but what You [will]. AMPC

Can you say that today? Nevertheless, no worries, I will do it anyway. Even though I just want to quit, I won't. Even though I'm tired and weary in well-doing. Even though one of my best friends is about to betray me with a kiss, I won't let that hurt Me because he knows not what He does.

Just go through it. You will be richly rewarded and you will be recognized as God's. You will inherit eternal life!

When you have stood that test, whatever that test is, you didn't quit. You didn't give up, but you overcame, and then you will receive the victor's crown! That day will come; now decide you are in it for the duration! Whatever it takes for that victor's crown, which is the reward of eternal life.

James 1:12 "Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him." It emphasizes that enduring temptation and trials with faith leads to a divine reward, highlighting endurance, love for God, and eternal life. NIV

ARE YOU STILL SLEEPING?

Matthew 7:21 Not everyone who says to Me, Lord, Lord, will enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father Who is in heaven. 22 Many will say to Me on that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name and driven out demons in Your name and done many mighty works in Your name? 23 And then I will say to them openly (publicly), I never knew you; depart from Me, you who act wickedly [disregarding My commands].

Jesus showed me one day how sad He is to have to say I didn't know you. It tears His heart out to have to say it but He has to, because He is not a respecter of persons.

He knows many will perish and in that, He is suffering just like the day He was arrested. He knew what was to come and He knows many will perish.

Wake up. The time is near and you don't know if you are ready, only Jesus knows.

Seek Him. Get up and listen for His voice.

Mark 14:41 All of you must keep awake (give strict attention, be cautious and active) and watch and pray, that you may not come into temptation. The spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

Jesus said this to the disciples because they kept falling asleep while He was praying. He knew what was about to happen and brought them there for their support, yet they slept.

Jesus warned us of His return. He said just as in the day of Noah, will be the coming of the Son of Man. Just as He said to the disciples that day, and just as they fell asleep, we also are sleeping. What Jesus said to the disciples that day, He is saying to us today. "Be cautious and active, watch and pray that you may not come into temptation."

Jesus may be waking us up at three in the morning to warn us of our condition to tell us things to come, so that we can be ready that day—but we roll over and go back to sleep. We, just like disciples when each time Jesus came back to check on them, are asleep. Each morning Jesus wakes us up, we put Him off and go back to sleep. "Oh, it's too early Lord, we'll talk later." Later never comes. Your day is too busy and Jesus never got to tell you what you needed to know. The disciples never prayed, their flesh got in the way. The same thing is happening now, we are not praying because we are too tired.
